

What is Cursillo?

Cursillo is a short course in Christianity. It is a three day spiritual retreat in which the main activity is learning about God's love for us and Christ's will for us.

Cursillo is a wonderful expression of God's love, full of singing, learning, laughter, surprises, new friendships – all reflected in God's people.

Its basic message is that Christianity is a way of life rather than a set of doctrines. It is a highly structured, purposefully designed method for refreshing the faith of individuals, and through the individuals, the environments in which they live and work.

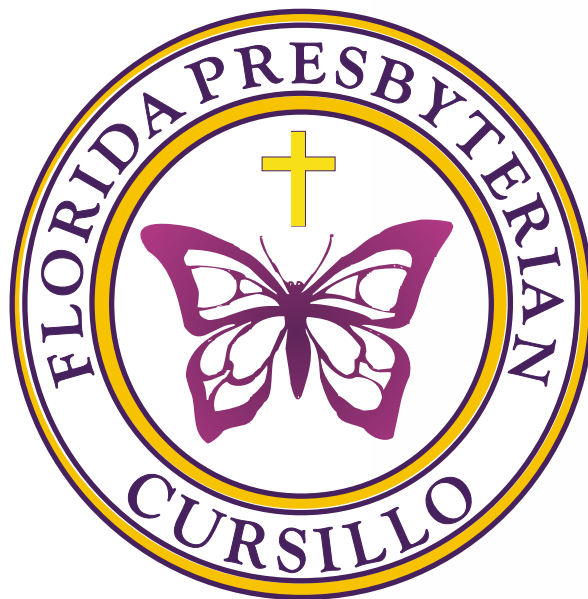

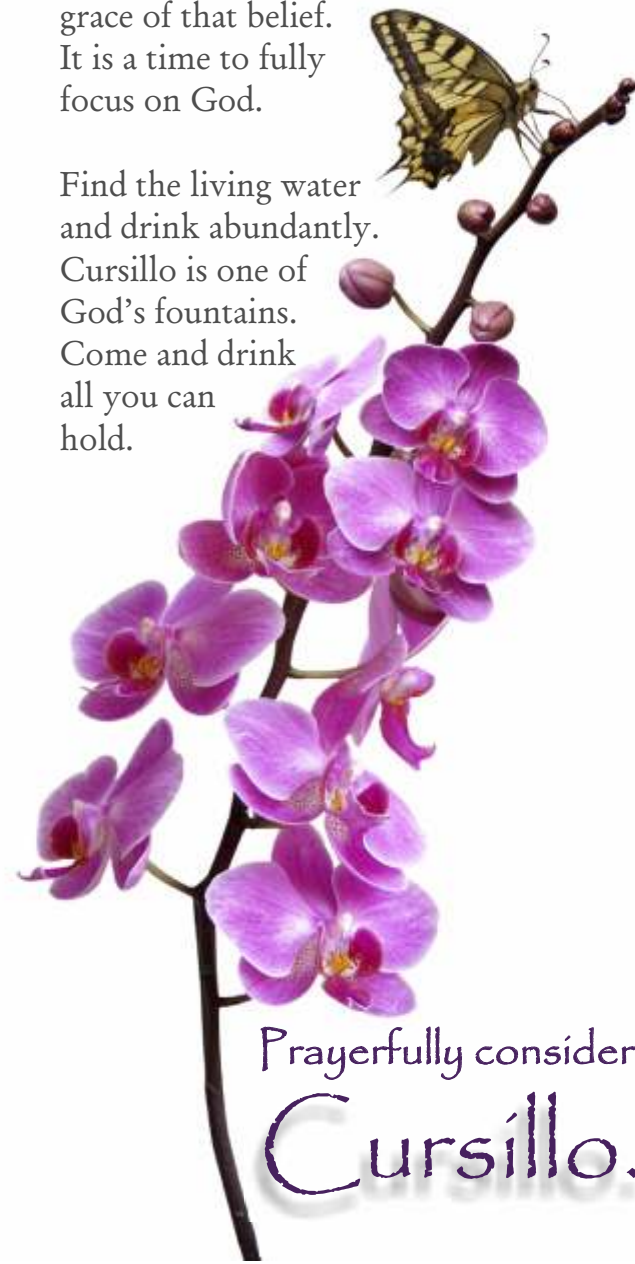
